#88-07(3) COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE recommending that the sum of \$34,500 be appropriated from the Community Preservation Fund FY 2007 General Reserve, including legal fees in the amount of \$30,000 and bond issuance costs in the amount of \$4,500, in connection with the acquisition of 20 Rogers Street, whether by purchase or eminent domain, for recreational use. (144-06) COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE recommending that the sum of \$1.44 M plus \$7,300 in legal fees be appropriated from the CPA fund Historic Preservation Fund Balance; FY 2007 Historic Preservation Reserve; and FY 2007 CPA General Reserve, for phase I funding for the Durant Kenrick Homestead restoration and rehabilitation project, as a grant. The CPC further recommends that the funds be appropriated under the control of the Newton History Museum (Jackson Homestead) and that certain terms included in the CPC recommendation be incorporated in the agreement between the City and the Newton Historical Society.
