ORDINANCE NO. Z-49

May 18, 2009

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
OF THE CITY OF NEWTON AS FOLLOWS:

That the provisions of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Newton, Massachusetts, 2007, as amended, be and are hereby further amended as follows:

1. In Section **Sec. 29-36. Rates, schedule.**, as most recently amended by Ordinance Z-29, dated June 2, 2008:

A. Delete the following provisions of subsection (a) (1) of section 29-36 relative to water rates:

Four dollars and fifteen cents (\$4.15) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 0 to 20 hundred cubic feet;

Four dollars and ninety-eight cents (\$4.98) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 21 to 70 hundred cubic feet;

Five dollars and ninety-eight cents (\$5.98) per hundred cubic feet for consumption above 70 hundred cubic feet

B. Insert the following new provisions, which shall take effect as of July 1, 2009:

Four dollars and thirty-five cents (\$4.35) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 0 to 20 hundred cubic feet;

Five dollars and twenty-two cents (\$5.22) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 21 to 70 hundred cubic feet;

Six dollars and twenty-six cents (\$6.26) per hundred cubic feet for consumption above 70 hundred cubic feet

2. In Section **Sec. 29-80. Sewer/Stormwater Use Charge.**, as most recently amended by Ordinance Z-29, dated June 2, 2008:

A. Delete the following provisions of subsection (b)(1)b) of section 29-80 relative to sewer rates:

Five dollars and eighty-one cents (\$5.81) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 0 to 20 hundred cubic feet;

Six dollars and ninety-seven cents (\$6.97) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 21 to 70 hundred cubic feet;

Eight dollars and thirty-six cents (\$8.36) per hundred cubic feet for consumption above 70 hundred cubic feet;


B. Insert the following new provisions, which shall take effect as of July 1, 2009:

Six dollars and eighty-one cents (\$6.81) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 0 to 20 hundred cubic feet;

Eight dollars and seventeen cents (\$8.17) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 21 to 70 hundred cubic feet;

Nine dollars and eighty cents (\$9.80) per hundred cubic feet for consumption above 70 hundred cubic feet;


