Acres in the Falls is designed to meet the needs of Newton's middle school population. It features weekly themes and trips for boys and girls entering grades 5, 6, 7 and 8.

- Registration begins on February 2, 2010 for Newton residents and on March 1, 2010 for non residents and continues until the program is full.

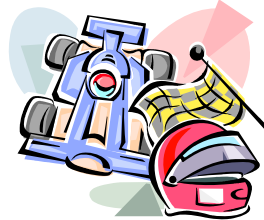
