Cabins:

Campers and counselors will sleep together in cabins. There will be 1 counselor with 4 – 7 campers in each cabin. Cabins are split up by gender. There are bathrooms with showers in each cabin. Cabins are air conditioned and the beds have sheets, pillows and comforters on them.

Groups:

Each camper will be assigned to a group with one of our Parks and Recreation staff. This staff person will also sleep in the cabin with their group. Parents are welcome to write down specific information about your son or daughter to give to staff prior to getting on the bus. Campers must stay with their group at all times. Campers will not be allowed to go anywhere alone.

Meals:

Meals are provided at Club Getaway and include a variety of items including breakfast items, chicken fingers and fries, pasta, salad bars, hamburgers and hot dogs, macaroni and cheese, pizza and a variety of desserts. If your camper has any special dietary requirements please convey that information to us on the registration form.

Programming:

Day programming: Our camp will be on a specific schedule during the day as there will be many other groups at Club Getaway. The activities will be lead by Club Getaway staff in conjunction with our Parks and Recreation Staff. Our Camp Directors work with Club Getaway staff on setting up a schedule that is most appropriate for our campers to ensure that they are having fun and staying safe.

Evening programming: In the evening, Club Getaway generally has joint activities for all of their camps i.e. Game Show, Getaway Madness, Karaoke, Campfires and DJ Dance Party.

Medical Needs:

The camp health supervisors for our group and will be taking care of any minor first aid issues that arise. An EMT is also available between the hours of 9:00 am and 6:00 pm. If we need a medical facility we will utilize New Milford Hospital, which is approximately 20 minutes away.
