

## INFORMATION FOR REGISTRATION AND ATTENDING CAMP

- Centre Acres offers seven one week sessions: July 5 through August 19, 2011.
- Choose one or all of the weeks offered. A \$30.00 per week non-refundable deposit is required with the registration.
- Children are placed with others by the grade entering in school. One counselor per 5 - 8 children depending on age.
- All children receive a Centre Acres T-shirt. Campers should come to camp dressed in comfortable clothing including sneakers and socks. Campers should bring a bathing suit and towel each day. A water bottle, lunch and snacks should be brought from home.
