Directions to Nahanton Park

From Mass. Pike: Take Rt. 128-S to Highland Ave., Needham (Exit 19B). Turn left at first set of lights onto Hunting Rd. Follow ½ mile to lights and turn left onto Kendrick St. Nahanton Park is on the left after crossing the Charles River.

From Newton City Hall: Take Commonwealth Ave. to Walnut St. through Newton Highlands. Turn right onto Centre St. at lights and proceed under Rt. 9 overpass, continuing straight to lights at Winchester St. Follow Winchester St. to end, turn right onto Nahanton St. Nahanton Park is ¼ mile on right.

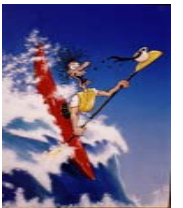
