

**Items accepted year round
at the Rumford Ave Resource
Recovery Center:**

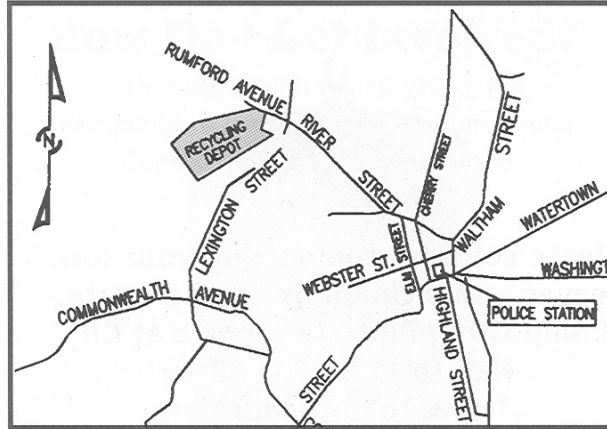
- Rechargeable batteries (nickel cadmium, nickel metal hydride)
- Silver oxide, mercuric oxide, lithium button batteries, and automotive batteries
- Devices containing mercury (fluorescent bulbs, thermostats, switches, thermometers)
- PAINT EXCHANGE: Paints, stains, polyurethane (clean and reusable interior/exterior oil or latex), unexpired shellac (M-F, from mid-May through mid-October only)
- Empty propane tanks



**Some products, which have
been considered hazardous in
the past, can now be disposed of
with regular trash:**

- Alkaline batteries (AAA, AA, C, D, and 9 volt)
- Smoke Detectors
- Latex paint (must be dried out; use sand, kitty litter, or “quick dry” crystals to speed up the process)
- Soiled bandages in plastic bags, securely fastened
- Driveway sealer (latex or oil based)

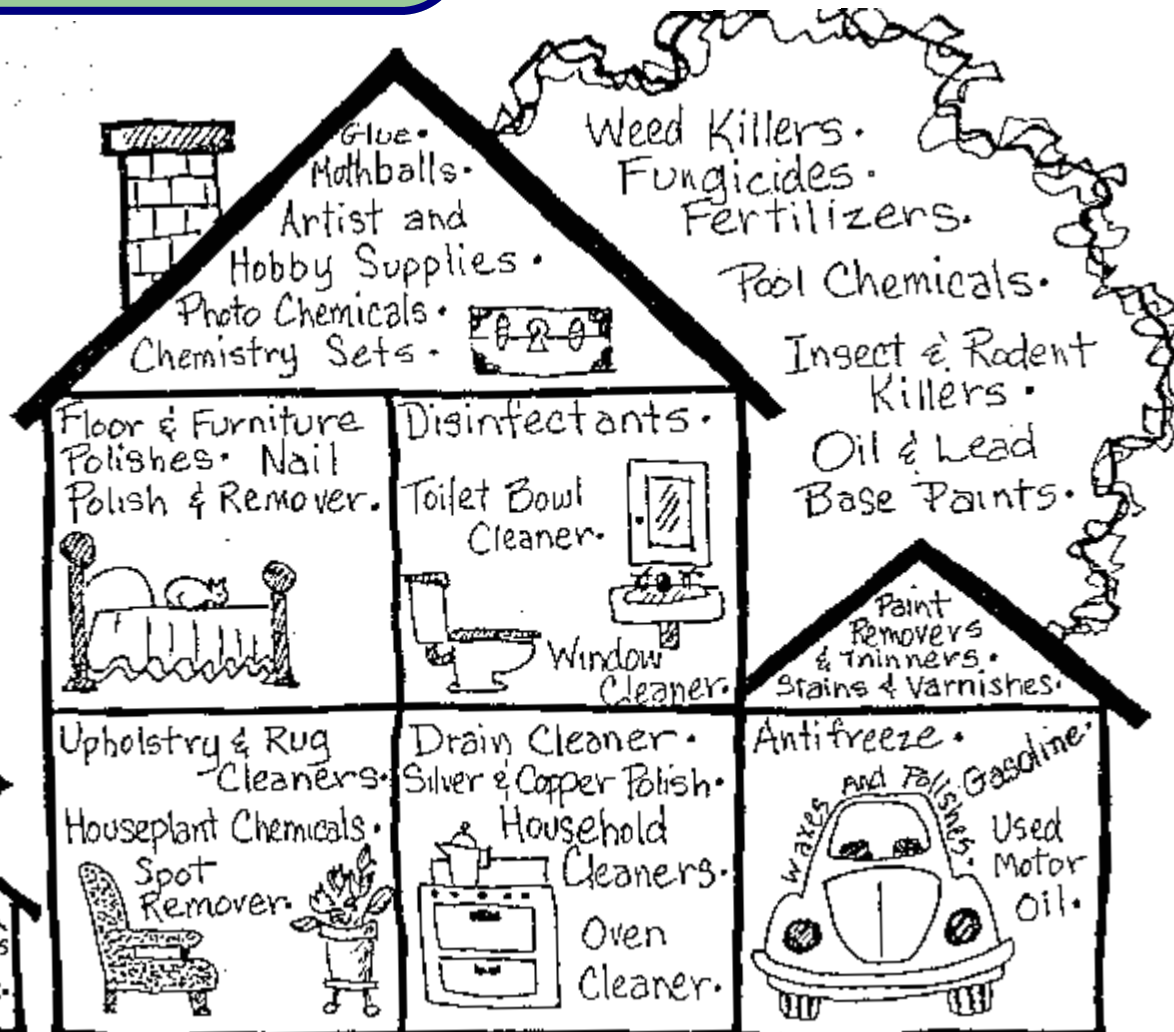

What to Bring...

What NOT to Bring...



- **DO NOT BRING LATEX PAINT (dry out and place with trash)**
- Empty aerosol cans (recycle curbside)
- Commercial/Industrial waste
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Ammunition, fireworks, explosives
- Prescription medicines/syringes
- Infectious/biological wastes
- Propane, butane, other flammable gases
- Fire extinguishers
- Smoke detectors (place in trash)
- Construction materials
- Radioactive waste
- Empty containers
- Non-hazardous materials
- Asbestos
- Tires, PCBs

How to transport safely...

- Leave materials in original container
- Tighten caps and lids, seal bags
- Sort and pack separately
- Never mix chemicals
- Pack in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper—no leaking/exposed items accepted
- Do not place waste in a garbage bag
- Never smoke while handling hazardous materials

Managing Hazardous products...

- Minimize the use of hazardous products
- Look for alternates
- Read labels carefully
- Use according to directions
- Store products safely
- Buy only what you need
- Use up the products or share what is left over

No more than 5-gallons of a single material and no more than 12-gallons total.
