

Historic Newton Wins NEMA Publication Award

New England Museum Association's Publication Awards

Historic Newton is proud to announce that it was one of the winners of the New England Museum Association's 2010 Publication Awards in the Annual Fund, Capital Campaign & Other Development Materials category. This year, there were 241 publications submitted from 78 museums for consideration in 19 different categories.

Placing second, our case booklet, *The Campaign for Historic Newton: A Window of Opportunity* was applauded by the judges for its "combination of type faces and how they were used throughout for emphasis. That, as well as how images were used to draw the reader through the piece made it a particularly successful piece."

The New England Museum Association sponsors its annual Publication Awards Program to recognize excellence in design, production, and effective communication in all aspects of museum publishing. The judges for the print publications category were Serena Furman, A Space Exhibit Design and Development, and David Hazeltine, V.P., Fundraising, DMW Worldwide LLC.
