ORDINANCE Z-19

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF NEWTON AS FOLLOWS:

That the traffic regulations of the City of Newton, Revised Ordinances of Newton, Massachusetts, 2007, as amended, be and are hereby further amended as follows:

1. Delete in its entirety **Sec. 19-172(c). The following locations are designated as loading zones which have a thirty minute time limits.**

Delete in its entirety **Sec. 19-172(d). The following locations are designated as loading zones which shall have a ten minute time limits.**

2. Delete in its entirety **Sec. 19-180. Stopping Prohibited on Particular Streets.**

3. Delete in **Sec. 19-220. Parking prohibitions for tow zones.** the list of locations beginning with *Acacia Avenue* and ending with *Tudor Road*.

4. In **Sec. 19-221. Signs to be erected.** Delete the following text:

“Temporary signs bearing the scheduled time of game commencement shall be placed at the following locations on the day that football game day parking restrictions are in effect:

Commonwealth Avenue, at the Boston line;

Beacon Street, at the Boston Line;

Hammond Street, at the Brookline line; *Centre Street*, at Cabot Street;

Centre Street, at Beacon Street;

Beacon Street, at Centre Street;

Commonwealth Avenue, at Centre Street;

Hammond Pond Parkway, at Beacon Street;

Waverley Avenue, at Kenrick Street.”

5. Upon the effective date of this ordinance, the provisions of the above sections of the Revised Ordinances shall be adopted as Traffic and Parking Regulations, which shall be in effect until the traffic council adopts and publishes Traffic and Parking Regulations as provided in Section 19-27 b).
