ORDINANCE NO. Z-39

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE CITY OF NEWTON AS FOLLOWS:

That the Revised Ordinances of Newton, Massachusetts, 2007, as amended, be and are hereby further amended with respect to Chapter 19 **Motor Vehicles and Traffic** as follows:

1. Delete in its entirety the language contained in paragraph (5) b) of subsection A. *Resident Sticker Parking*, of Section 19-200 **Resident sticker and visitor permit; municipal lot parking program**, and insert in its place the following language:

b) The chief of police may establish rules governing the display of resident parking stickers.

2. Delete in its entirety the language contained in paragraph (3) of subsection B. *Visitor Permit Parking* of Section 19-200 **Resident sticker and visitor permit; municipal lot parking program**, and insert in its place the following language:

(3) The chief of police may establish rules governing the display of resident parking stickers.


3. Delete in its entirety the language contained in paragraph (5) b) of subsection B. *Issuance of resident parking stickers* of Section 19-201 **Resident sticker and visitor permit parking program**, and insert in its place the following language:

b) The chief of police may establish rules governing the display of resident parking stickers.

4. Delete in its entirety the language contained in paragraph (6) of subsection C. *Issuance of visitor parking permits* of Section 19-201 **Resident sticker and visitor permit parking program**, and insert in its place the following language:


(6) The chief of police may establish rules governing the display of resident parking stickers


