Dear Mayor Warren,

As you know, the current construction activities at the Newton North High School Project include the dismantling of scaffolding. On a few occasions, construction activities that are critical to the schedule will require working weekends to ensure deadlines are met to facilitate the next critical scope of work. We are planning to dismantle the scaffolding inside the pool area on Sunday, February 21, 2010. As we take down the scaffolding, we will store it outside for pickup on Monday. We will be utilizing a Lull outside the building to assist in removal and storage of the scaffolding. Total usage of the lull will be minimal since all work will be done inside the building.

Dimeo Construction is aware that pursuant to section 20-13 (f)(2) of the City's Noise ordinance, the generation of noise from the outdoor construction activities can only occur between the hours of 7:00 am, and 7:00 pm on weekdays. In order to comply with these time restrictions in the Noise Ordinance with the dismantling of scaffolding inside the building. Dimeo has taken the following steps; Keeping all working activities inside the building, and minimizing the after-hour use of intrusive back up alarms.

Unfortunately, however, Dimeo Construction does not have control over the time lost associated with the weather. While we are committed to avoiding the need to conduct this construction activity beyond normal working hours, this is critical to the overall schedule for the completion of the project.

Accordingly, pursuant to the provisions of Section 20-13 (h)(1) of the Noise Ordinance, Dimeo is requesting a temporary Permit for Exemption from the Noise Ordinance's restriction, effective Sunday, February 21, 2010 from 8:00 to 4:30, for the limited purpose of completing the dismantling of scaffold as described in this request.
