Dear Newton North High School Neighbors:

This summer we have made excellent progress on the building of the new Newton North High School. On July 2nd we held a groundbreaking ceremony where local officials took sledgehammers to the old Dickenson Stadium. Since then, the stadium has been demolished, and the site preparation has continued as we prepare for the heavy construction that will soon follow. We are on our way to build an outstanding state-of-the-art community facility that will enhance the educational experience for many future generations of Newton North students.

We write to invite you to an important meeting regarding the construction of our new Newton North High School. On Tuesday, September 18, we will present a progress report on the building of our new high school. **The meeting will take place in the Newton North High School Auditorium, beginning at 6:30 p.m.** At the meeting, officials will review the construction plan, discuss construction impacts, and outline measures being taken to protect the health and safety of the building occupants, neighbors, workers, and the general public.

We have worked hard to establish an open and public process for this important and complex project. In April 2007, the Mayor created the Newton North High School Liaison Committee, which includes neighborhood representatives and elected and appointed officials. The Liaison Committee provides a public forum to offer input and share information on the construction of our new Newton North High School.
